VISION RADIOLOGY "CODE STROKE" PROTOCOL

The Protocol will be defined by hospital policies, but includes any patient in which an intervention may be appropriate (i.e, TPA, neuro interventional radiology).

- 1. The patient is scanned and images transmitted to Vision Radiology ("Vision").
- 2. Check the Vision Tech Portal to confirm that the images have been received. Once received, the technologist calls (510) 683-9500 (press 1) to alert Vision of a Code Stroke case.

Note: If the person answering the phone at Vision is a Radiology Assistant, or a Radiologist who is not credentialed by the hospital, the information will be relayed to a Radiologist with appropriate credentials. If the technologist needs to speak with the interpreting Radiologist they will be transferred.

3. After calling Vision, please complete the order/history in Vision's tech portal. Please include a 10 digit telephone number, bed number and RN for any inpatients. The results will be called in by a Vision radiologist to the appropriate staff member as soon as possible.

KEY: If the technologist does not call to inform Vision that a case is a Code Stroke protocol requiring prioritization, it will be read as routine emergent.
